Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondent to take appropriate legal action on the complaint dated 29.08.2019 (Annexure P10) submitted by the petitioner and for registration of the FIR regarding the action of respondents No.5 and 6, who had tried to sell the property of their deceased brother Karnail Singh by entering into an agreement to sell which is subsequent to the date of death of Karnail Singh.

Reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar filed in the Court is taken on record and as per the reply, on an enquiry conducted by the police and after obtaining the opinion of the District Attorney (Legal), an FIR No.13 dated 11.01.2020 under Sections 193, 420 IPC stands registered against respondent No.5 – Amrik Singh at Police Station City Nawanshahar.

In view of the above, no further action is called for.

Disposed of accordingly. However, it will be open for the petitioner to approach the Illaqa Magistrate for redressal of his grievance, if any.
