Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 467 dated 27.08.2019 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner in the process of recruitment for the post of constable in para military forces and during Physical Endurance Test (PET) and Physical Strength Test (PST) was found having laminated fake finger prints in his left hand.

He further states that the allegations are false, the petitioner has been in custody since 29.08.2019, the challan has been filed and the charges have not been framed.

On the instructions from SI Vishwajeet, learned State counsel has not disputed the fact regarding the custody period of the petitioner and further states that charges are yet to be framed.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties. The petitioner has been in custody since 29.08.2019 and charges are yet to be framed, the trial will take time to conclude and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
