The grievance of the petitioner is that despite representations dated 21.09.2016 (Annexure P-11) and dated 12.09.2018 (Annexure P-12) having been made, no action is being taken upon them.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the original allottee sold part of his allotment to the petitioner and put him in possession of the same. The application of the private respondents under the East Punjab Holdings (Consolidation and Prevention of Fragmentation) Act, 1948 (hereinafter referred to as the Act) for allotment of the same land to them was rejected. Thereafter, the State of Punjab filed an application under the Act which was allowed ex parte. The order of the Additional Director, Consolidation of Holdings, Punjab, Jalandhar passed in exercise of jurisdiction under Section 42 of the Act was however stayed by this Court in a writ petition filed by the petitioner. The writ petition was finally allowed and the order of the Additional Director, Consolidation of Holdings, Punjab,

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Jalandhar was set aside. However, meanwhile, the State of Punjab allotted the land in dispute to the private respondents and they dispossessed the petitioner. The allotment in favour of the private respondents has been cancelled as per order of this Court but the revenue record has still not been corrected.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider the representations dated 21.09.2016 (Annexure P-11) and dated 12.09.2018 (Annexure P-12) and to pass an appropriate order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
