Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.359 dated 02.11.2018, registered under Sections 201, 302 and 364 IPC, at Police Station City Sohna, District Gurugram.

Learned State counsel admits the submissions of learned counsel for petitioner that all the material prosecution witnesses have turned hostile. Thus, as on date, there is no incriminating material against the petitioner to keep him behind bars.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and that all the prosecution witnesses have turned hostile, the petition is allowed.

Consequently, petitioner Manjeet is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, if not required in any other case, on his

furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
