The plaintiff-petitioner has filed the present revision petition against an order Annexure P-13, dated 24.5.2019, refusing to restore the possession of house No.B-11, Ward No.4, Village Sahnewal Kalan, Tehsil and District Ludhiana. It is undisputed that the suit filed by the plaintiff-petitioner for grant of decree of permanent injunction is pending before the Trial Court. The plaintiff had prayed for restoration of possession on the strength of order of injunction passed in her favour.

Learned counsel for the parties have informed the Court that in the meantime, proceedings in the suit have made substantial progress and now the case is fixed for defendant's evidence.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to direct the learned Trial Court to conclude the hearing of the suit positively within a period of three months from the next date of hearing i.e 23.3.2020. It is clarified that if the Court, while deciding the final suit comes to a conclusion that the plaintiff was dispossessed

during the pendency of the suit, it shall be entitled to mould the relief and order restoration of the possession to the plaintiff.
