Appellant-Sarita Maan, Lecturer in Physics was transferred from Government Polytechnic, Nilokheri to Government Polytechnic Ambala vide transfer order dated 12.6.2017 in place of respondent-Preeti Srivastava who was ordered to join in her place. However, Respondent-Preeti Srivastva and her husband Parveen Mohan, also working as Lecturers/Senior Lecturers in Physics, filed a writ petition bearing CWP No.13871 of 2017 assailing their transfer from Govt. Polytechnic, Ambala to Nilokheri vide the aforesaid transfer order. Mr. Parveen Mohan was to

The appellant after being relieved had joined at Ambala. The aforesaid writ petition was allowed by the learned Single Judge vide the impugned order dated 6.9.2017, whereby the transfer of the appellant from Nilokheri, to Ambala was set aside, while permitting Preeti Srivastva to continue at Govt. Polytechnic, Ambala. No relief was given qua Mr. Parveen Mohan, who had joined at Nilokheri. Hence the present intra court appeal.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel points out that apart from Preeti Srivastva being permitted to continue at Ambala, her husband Mr. Parveen Mohan has also been posted back at Ambala being a couple case. He submits that appellant Sarita Mann in light of the interim orders passed in the present LPA was also permitted to continue at Government Polytechnic, Ambala. It is not disputed that each year, general transfers are made keeping in view the administrative exigencies.

As far as the present *lis* is concerned, parties having worked since 2017 at their respective place of postings, would be liable to be transferred as per the Policy as and when the exigencies exists.

In view of the efflux of time, we find the present appeal has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
