The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.56 dated 05.05.2019 under Sections 354-D and 506 read with Section 34 IPC as well as Section 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Cantt. Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 29.11.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.11.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
