Petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 276 dated 29.06.2019 registered under Section 20 of the NDPS Act, 1959 at Police Station Thanesar Sadar, District Kurukshetra.

Quantity of contraband allegedly recovered from the petitioner is more than small quantity but less than commercial quantity. He was arrested on 29.06.2019. Vide order dated 16.11.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court on the ground that the petitioner having been in custody since 29.06.2019 with the charge still to be framed and the quantity of contraband recovered from him (as per the case of the prosecution) being

admittedly less than commercial quantity. With this observation, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court, till the next date of hearing. Interim bail remained in operation till date.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Surender states that challan has been presented, but charges have not been framed so far. Petitioner is also involved in one more case at similar nature and he is on bail in that case also.

Looking at the non-commercial quantity in nature and without meaning anything on merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove, shall be construed to be an opinion on merits of the case.
