In compliance of order dated 03.10.2019, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced receipt of ₹10,000/-. The same is taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.58 dated 05.08.2013, registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Phul, District Bathinda and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of settlement/agreement/compromise

(Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 03.10.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 21.10.2019 to get their statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Phul, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.601 dated 01.11.2019, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Bathinda, vide Endst. No.1842/EB dated 02.11.2019.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is genuine and without any pressure or coercion.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR No.58 dated 05.08.2013, registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Phul, District Bathinda and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners with the quarters concerned.
