The petitioners have prayed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to relocate/shift the existing Hadda Rori situated in Khewat No.497/478 Khatauni No. 524, Khasra No.217, measuring 6 kanal 19 marla of village Hathur, Tehsil Jagraon and District Ludhiana to some alternate place, at a reasonable distance from the residential area/Abadi.

After notice, respondents have filed their reply, in which, it is averred in para No.4 that the Gram Panchayat can shift its Hadda Rori to the Khasra No.228 but the same could be done only after creating a new passage to that land which is possible only after harvesting of Hari crop.

Counsel for the petitioners is satisfied with the reply filed by the State and submits that the present petition has become infructuous, at this stage.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the State shall make all efforts to shift the present site of Hadda Rori to Khasra No.228 after harvesting the Hari crop.

In view thereof, the present petition has become infructuous.
