In compliance of order dated 28.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced receipts of ₹20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.121 dated 24.10.2018, registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 34 IPC, at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 01.10.2019 of Coordinate Bench, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 06.11.2019 to get their statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Garhshankar, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.638 dated 02.12.2019, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur, vide Endst. No.30405 dated 03.12.2019.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is genuine and without any coercion or undue influence.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR No.121 dated 24.10.2018, registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 34 IPC, at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners with the quarters.
