The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.53, dated 14.03.2019, under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, registered at Women Police Station Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

As per the report, received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the parties have amicably settled their dispute. The factum of matter having been settled between the parties is not disputed by the learned counsel for the complainant.

It has also been apprised to the Court that the parties are now living together as husband and wife.

In view of the above, the instant petition is allowed. It is, however, made clear that in future, if the petitioner is required to be arrested in the instant case, he shall be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investing Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
