Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.13 dated 29.08.2019 registered under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Phase 8, Distt. Mohali.

Notice of motion was issued on 01.10.2019. Vide order dated 27.11.2019, the petitioner was directed to surrender before the Investigating Officer and to join investigation. On doing so, he was to be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh submitted that pursuant to the order dated

27.11.2019, the petitioner has given his voice sample on 10.12.2019 and has joined the investigation on 03.12.2019. Petitioner is no more required in any further investigation of the case.

In view of above, interim order dated 27.11.2019 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when directed to do so and he shall be abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
