The present petition has been filed by the petitioner-Mohan Lal, Sub-Inspector, *inter alia*, praying for quashing of the impugned transfer order dated 12.09.2019 (Annexure P-4).

Perusal of the order dated 12.09.2019 (Annexure P-4) shows that 33 officers were transferred to different places. The petitioner, *herein* was transferred from Panchkula to Narnaul.

The records of the case show that on 01.10.2019, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion for 23.01.2020.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s)/State and prays for time to file reply.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, there shall be interim stay of impugned transfer order dated 12.09.2019 (Annexure P-4) as well as relieving order qua petitioner.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner on resumed hearing of the

case, submits that the petitioner has since retired on 31.01.2020. He further submits that he however continued working at Narnaul and for some technical reasons the order of this Court could not be given effect to.

Therefore, in view of peculiar circumstances of the case, no further orders are called for.

Writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
