Mr. Deepak Kansal, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent No.2 by filing vakalatnama, which be taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has brought a demand draft in the sum of Rs.2,50,000/-. The said demand draft has been handed over to learned counsel for respondent No.2. Photocopy thereof has been placed on file.

Under the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender in the trial Court within one week and move appropriate application for setting aside of the order declaring him as a proclaimed offender. Such application is then to be disposed of by the trial Court within two weeks. Till then, the petitioner may not be arrested. However, this order is subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) he shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing;
- (ii) he shall not give any threat or intimidation to the prosecution witnesses; and
- (iii) he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if he has got one, otherwise to furnish affidavit in that regard.
