Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 301 dated 10.09.2019 registered under Section 307 IPC, Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Section 3(2)(v) of The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Jind Sadar, District Jind.

Vide order dated 03.10.2019, the petitioner was granted interim bail, subject to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 03.10.2019.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Narender Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation but the recovery is yet to be effected from him.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant states that the compromise has been effected between the parties and he has no objection, if the order dated 03.10.2019 is made absolute.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 03.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
