Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case arising from FIR No.205 dated 30.08.2019, registered under Section 420 IPC, at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda.

According to prosecution, petitioner induced the complainant for a huge amount of Rs.10,00,000/- for appointment of his son Lovedeep Singh as Inspector in Cooperative Society.

In compliance of order dated 12.12.2019, learned counsel for petitioner, on instructions, submits that petitioner is not ready to refund the alleged cheated amount of `7,40,000/-.

Heard.

Considering the overall facts and circumstances, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of bail, sought by him.

Dismissed.
