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**RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (Oral)**

In compliance of order dated 28.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioners have produced receipts of ₹20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.162 dated 25.11.2016, registered under Sections 452, 341, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station City 1, Malerkotla, District Sangrur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 14.11.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 28.11.2019 to get their statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.49 dated 19.12.2019.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is result of free volition of the parties and without any inducement, threat or pressure.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR No.162 dated 25.11.2016, registered under Sections 452, 341, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station City 1, Malerkotla, District Sangrur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.
