Applicant-wife seeks transfer of petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 10 of the Hindu Marriage Act for judicial separation titled as “Shakti Sharma vs. Pooja Rani” pending in the Court of District Judge(Family Court), Pathankot, to the competent Court at Panipat.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that two more petitions filed by the applicant-wife are pending in the Court at Panipat.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

4. All the cases pending between the parties are outcome of matrimonial discord. Keeping in view the contentions in the application

and the conceded position that petitions under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, instituted at the instance of applicant-wife, are already pending in the Court at Panipat, wherein notice has been issued to the husband, it would be proper, appropriate and in the interest of justice, if all the cases are tried and decided at one place.

5. The present application is accordingly allowed. The petition in question is ordered to be withdrawn from the Court of District Judge (Family Court), Pathankot and is transferred to the competent Court at District Panipat.

6. Record of the case be sent to the District Judge, Panipat for its assignment to the Court concerned for disposal in accordance with law.
