Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents not to call the petitioners on the basis of some complaint as husband of petitioner No.1, father of petitioners No.2 to 4 namely Bhagwant Saingh is accused in some case of cheating and on that account, the police is harassing them.

Reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur filed in the Court is taken on record.

As per the reply, FIR No.19 dated 24.01.2019 under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Bhawanigarh was registered on the basis of the application No.6947/P dated 09.07.2018 from Jaspal Singh, against the petitioner and her husband Bhagwant Singh and after carrying on the investigation, petitioner No.1 – Rupinder Kaur was found to be innocent, however, her husband Bhagwant Singh was found to be the actual culprit and he was arrested on 15.02.2020. It is further

stated that on completion of the investigation, challan will be present in due course.

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition, at this stage.
