The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 623 dated 02.10.2017, registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 of the IPC (Sections 201 and 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

On 14.10.2019, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was found innocent in investigation and was not charge-sheeted. She has been summoned by the trial Court on application of complainant under Section 319 Cr.P.C. The petitioner is ready to face trial and her custodial interrogation is no more required. Notice of motion for 20.01.2020. Petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, within two weeks and on her appearance, she shall be released on interim bail, till the next date, on her furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in

pursuance to the order dated 14.10.2019, has already appeared before the trial Court and she has been released on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Isham Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 14.10.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
