The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.121 dated 15.09.2019 under Sections 452, 384, 506, 498-A, 323, 294, 342, 354, 354-A, 509, 354-D and 380 IPC as well as Section 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 21.11.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 21.11.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
