In compliance of order dated 30.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced receipt of ₹ 20,000/-. The same are taken on record. Registry is directed to verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners with the concerned quarter.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.112 dated 19.05.2018 registered under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468 & 471 IPC at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 30.01.2020 of this Court, the parties appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Gurdaspur, on

21.11.2019 to get their statements recorded. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.1188 dated 21.11.2019, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, vide letter No.19656/RKT dated 23.11.2019.

According to the above report, compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR No.112 dated 19.05.2018 registered under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468 & 471 IPC at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.
