In this petition, the petitioners, who are the accused persons in FIR No.232 dated 19.03.2017 registered under Sections 148/149/323/325/506 IPC, 1860 at Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1) has prayed for quashing of FIR along with all subsequent proceedings, on the basis of Compromise Deed dated 05.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the respondent No.2-complainant has arrived at a settlement with the accused persons/petitioners, vide Compromise Deed dated 05.07.2019 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by him. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

3. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, vide report dated 23.01.2020, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is voluntarily.

4. There is no representation on behalf of complainant, which shows that complainant has no objection to the quashing of FIR.

5. In view of the report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, and in view of the decisions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **“Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **“Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466**, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainant has himself compromised the dispute with the accused persons/petitioners.

6. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.232 dated 19.03.2017 registered under Sections 148/149/323/325/506 IPC, 1860 at Police Station City Ballabhgarh, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
