JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (ORAL)

On 14.10.2019, notice of motion was issued in this case and it was directed that in the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, vide order dated 21.11.2019, the order was modified to the extent that the petitioners shall appear before the trial Court, instead of appearing before the investigating officer.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners have already surrendered before the trial Court on 17.12.2019, wherein they were summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. and have also been admitted on interim bail.

In view of above, order dated 14.10.2019, as modified vide order dated 21.11.2019, whereby the petitioners were granted interim protection is hereby made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
