This order shall dispose of the aforementioned two criminal
revisions as the same have arisen out of the common judgment dated
23.09.2019 passed by learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Sirsa, whereby

on a petition filed by the wife and minor son, under Section 125 Cr.P.C., the family Court has directed the husband to pay maintenance @ Rs.8,000/- per month i.e. Rs.3,000/- per month for the wife and Rs.5,000/- per month for minor son, from the date of filing of the petition.

The husband, namely, Ashok Kumar has approached this Court for reducing the amount of maintenance, whereas the wife and minor son have sought enhancement of the amount of maintenance.

However, for convenience and clarity, the detailed order is being passed in *CRR(F) No.841 of 2019*.

Vide order dated 24.10.2019, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 27.11.2019.

As per the report dated 17.12.2019 received from the Mediator, the parties have settled their dispute by way of an amicable settlement/agreement dated 17.12.2019.

Since the matter has been compromised between the parties by way of settlement agreement dated 17.12.2019 arrived at the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of.

The settlement agreement dated 17.12.2019 is ordered to be made part of the record.

The parties shall adhere to the terms and conditions of the settlement agreement dated 17.12.2019 in its letter and spirit.
