Prayer in both these petitions is for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioners Sukhjinder Singh @ Sukha and Harnek Singh, in FIR No.88 dated 19.04.2019 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149, registered at Police Station City, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) has relied upon the order

dated 07.11.2019 passed in CRM-M-35556-2019, vide which co-accused Amrit Pal Singh @ Amrit was granted the concession of anticipatory bail, noticing the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, has not disputed the fact that the matter stands compromised between the parties.

In view of the above, both these petitions are allowed and the petitioners are granted anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

It will be open for the Investigating Officer to call the petitioners for the purpose of joining the investigation by giving an advance notice in writing, as and when they are required for further investigation.
