Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.96 dated 26.08.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A, 323 IPC (the offences under Sections 354-B, 377, 325 IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

In the pre-lunch session, after having interaction with the parties, who were present in the Court, this Court has directed them to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court today itself.

Pursuant thereto, parties have appeared before the Mediator.

Thereafter, it has been reported that the matter has now been compromised

between the parties and settlement/compromise dated 22.01.2020 entered between them has been reduced into writing. The settlement/compromise dated 22.01.2020 shall form part of the record.

Learned counsel for the complainant admits the factum of settlement/compromise dated 22.01.2020.

Since the matter has been compromised between the parties and settlement/compromise has been reduced into writing, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.10.2019 is hereby made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
