Prayer in the present petition is for grant of pre-arrest bail to petitioner in case F.I.R. No.30 dated 18.04.2019 under Sections 148, 307, 323, 324, 341, 342, 364 382, 452, 506 and 511 IPC read with Section 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Block Majri, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that alleged injury attributed to petitioner has been declared simple in nature but caused by sharp edged weapon.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Lakhmir Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 20.11.2019, petitioner has already joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

In view of above, order dated 20.11.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
