The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.205 dated 05.11.2018 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Adampur, Jalandhar Rural.

The operative part of the order dated 05.12.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only allegation against the petitioner is that his father, on receiving a sum of Rs.1.00 lac, has handed over to him and there is no direct allegation of conspiracy. It is further submitted that the petitioner is a student and is not actively involved in the business of his father.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that the petitioner be

directed to join the investigation....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 05.12.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, assisted by counsel for the complainant has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
