CM-6900-C-2019 is for disposal of the appeal under Order 23 Rule 3 CPC on the basis of a deed of settlement dated 27.7.2008.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents also does not dispute the correctness of the aforesaid settlement arrived at.

On careful perusal of the deed of settlement/compromise, it is apparent that only photocopy of the deed of settlement has been filed. On a Court question, learned counsel for the appellants submits that original of the aforesaid deed of settlement has been filed before the revenue authorities.

At this stage, he submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the appeal in view of the aforesaid settlement.

Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection to the same.

Hence, present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
