Complaint dated 02.10.2019 made by Amrik Singh s/o Kashmir Singh r/o H.No.25, Gali No.12, Near Garg School, Hargobind Nagar, Ludhiana was received by post in the Secretariat of Hon'ble the Chief Justice and was ordered to be listed on judicial side as habeas corpus writ petition.

In the above-said complaint Amrik Singh alleged that for the last 15 days concerned police official has been telephonically calling him to produce his son-Karan Singh @ Shanga in the Police Post Jagat Puri. The complainant took his son-Karan Singh @ Shanga to Police Post Jagat Puti on 01.10.2019 on the assurance that he would return back but the police illegally detained his son-Karan Singh @ Shanga without disclosing the matter for which he was so detained. The complainant accordingly expressed his apprehension that his son could be implicated in some false case.

Notice of the complaint treated as habeas corpus writ petition was given to the respondent-State.

Reply by of affidavit dated 10.01.2020 of Sh. Sameer Verma, PPS, ACP(West), Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State. In the said affidavit it has been submitted that Karan Singh @ Shanga son of the petitioner is not wanted in any criminal case. The police of Police Post Jagat Puri did not illegally detain Karan Singh @ Shanga on 01.10.2019. The petitioner has made false allegations against the police. His son came back to his house on 02.10.2019 and told the petitioner that he had gone for picnic with his friends and somebody had given him false information about apprehension of his son by the police of Police Post Jagat Puri. The petitioner had made statement to S.I. Malkeet Singh in this regard and also submitted that he did not want any further action to be taken on his complaint sent to Hon'ble the Chief Justice.

In view of the above-said reply, no further action is required to be taken on the present petition which is disposed of accordingly.
