This is a petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner against the order dated 13.03.2019 and 24.07.2019 passed by the Ld. ASJ, Ludhiana passed in FIR No.33 dated 15.04.2016 under Sections 341, 457, 379B (1) of IPC, 1960 registered at Hathur, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has jumped the bail and his bail bonds was forfeited. Vide order dated 14.10.2019, the petitioner was granted interim bail subject to deposit Rs. 5000/- with District Legal Services Authority, Ludhiana. He further submits that in compliance of order dated 14.10.2019 the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has deposited Rs.5000/- with District Legal Services Authority, Ludhiana on 24.10.2019 and the amount was deposited in Oriental Bank of Commerce, Ludhiana against Entry

No.189747. This factum has not been opposed by the learned State counsel

after having instructions from ASI Bahadur Singh.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
