Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.96 dated 26.08.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A, 323 IPC (the offences under Sections 354-B, 377, 325 IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Since the matter has now been compromised between the parties and settlement/compromise dated 22.01.2020 entered between them has been reduced into writing, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.10.2019, whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed, is hereby made absolute.

However, it is made clear that if the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days' notice be given to her.
