This revision arises out of a suit for damages filed by the family of the victim. The victim was murdered by Jaswinder Singh who was convicted on a charge of murder. The suit has been decreed for damages and towards victim compensation to be satisfied from the property of Jaswinder Singh by attachment and sale. In execution, the present petitioner-Charanjit Singh filed objections to the decree. The petitioner is the nephew of the wife of Jaswinder Singh. The objections have been dismissed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr.Divn.), Amloh by his order dated 4.12.2018. The trial court has not been impressed with the argument that the objector was a bona fide purchaser of the property of Jaswinder Singh. This was a ruse to escape from the liability. Accordingly, the petitioner has no locus standi justifying his intervention by way of objections in the execution proceedings. The petitioner challenged the judgment and decree of the trial court before the Additional District Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib which has been

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dismissed by him on 22.8.2019. I find no merit in this revision which is accordingly dismissed in limine.
