This application is filed for preponment of the main appeal and disposal thereof in terms of compromise arrived at between the parties.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

Main case is taken up for hearing today itself.

**RSA-5718-2015**

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that during pendency of the instant appeal both the parties i.e. appellant and respondent No.1, who are related to each other as real brother and sister, have settled the dispute and have arrived at a mutual settlement which has been reduced into writing vide Annexure A-1. According to the same, the parties have agreed to apportion the amount of Death-cum-Retirement benefits amongst themselves to the extent of 50% share each. This position has not been controverted by learned counsel for the respondents as the same has recorded in the order dated 16.10.2020 passed by this Court.

In view of the fact, the parties have mutually settled their dispute by way of a compromise Annexure A-1, the instant appeal stands disposed of in terms of said compromise. Compromise (Annexure A-1) be made part of the decree sheet. Parties are bound to comply with the terms and conditions enumerated there in. Respondent No.3 is directed to release the amount as per the terms of the compromise.
