Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.147 dated 24.05.2018 under Sections 148, 149, 365 IPC and Sections 323, 342, 367, 452 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of Deepak, on 15.04.2018, when he was going to Meham, Sandeep, Krishan, Vicky, Manidhar, Vikash, Vikram, Pona and some other persons came in two vehicles and forcibly put him in their vehicle and took him to the house of Somvir, where Sandeep, Vicky, Balwan, Manjeet, Bhoop Singh, Babla, Gulab, Krishan gave him beatings. It is further submitted that co-accused Manender, Dharmender, Vicky @ Shiv Kumar and Bijender @ Babla have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order 23.09.2019 passed in CRM-M-23986-2019, order dated 25.01.2019

passed in CRM-M-55058-2018, order dated 25.01.2019 passed in CRM-M-52248-2018 and the order dated 25.01.2019 passed in CRM-M-55120-2018, respectively. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 05.10.2019; he is not involved in any other case; challan against 13 persons has already been presented and it will take some time in conclusion of the trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajbir and on the basis of custody certificate, has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
