HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.101 dated 11.09.2019, registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 21 and 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

On 13.12.2019, learned State counsel submitted that sample was sent to the FSL but the report had not been received. In that scenario, the petitioner was allowed interim bail till date on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.

Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sohan Lal, submits that report of FSL has not been received so far.

A Division Bench of this Court in ***Inderjeet Singh @ Laddi and others vs State of Punjab*** has held that the accused-petitioner can be

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granted interim bail till the report of FSL is received.

Accordingly, the effect of order dated 13.12.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, shall remain in force till receiving of the FSL report. The petitioner shall submit an undertaking before the trial Court that he will surrender before it on the receipt of FSL report.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail, if the petitioner is found involved misusing the concession of bail, in any manner.
