Learned counsel for the petitioner, finding that this Court is not inclined to grant interim bail, submits that since the petitioner is under treatment at Govt. Medical College and Hospital, Sector-32, Chandigarh, which is not a super-specialty hospital, the police authorities/Jail Superintendent may be directed to get treatment of the petitioner done from PGIMS, Chandigarh.

This arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner is not opposed by learned State counsel.

Accordingly, it is directed that Superintendent, District Jail, Ropar as well as Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar shall ensure that further treatment of the petitioner is undertaken from PGIMS, Chandigarh.

With the aforesaid observations and directions, present petition stands disposed of.
