The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.74, dated 05.09.2019, under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 17.10.2019, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and no recovery is to be effected from him.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satpal, states that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, the recovery of gold ornaments has not been effected from him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has controverted the submissions of the State counsel by urging that nothing more requires to be effected from him as there are no allegations of any specific entrustment to him in the FIR in question.

On a query put to the learned State counsel, she has admitted that there was no allegation of any specific entrustment to the petitioner in the FIR in question.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 17.10.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
