Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.69 dated 06.09.2019 under Sections 323 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Women, Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Vide order dated 23.10.2019 passed by this Court, while staying the arrest of the petitioner, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, District Courts Complex, Fatehabad, where the petitioner and respondent No.2 were directed to appear on 07.11.2019.

A report dated 25.11.2019 has been received from the Chief Judicial Magistrate-cum-Secretary, DLSA-cum-Nodal Officer, District

Mediation & Conciliation Centre, Fatehabad that the compromise has been materialized between the parties and the mediation has been successful.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant does not dispute the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediator, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.10.2019 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be served upon him.
