This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 139 dated 17.5.2017 under Sections 323, 160 IPC and 379-B, 324 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station City Kapurthala District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that it is case of version and cross-version.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bagga Singh, states that both the versions i.e. version and cross-version advanced by the respective parties are found to be false during the course of investigation. The petitioners are not required for any further investigation in this case. Police has prepared the cancellation report of version and cross-version

and the same has been sent to the competent authority for approval.

In the light of the aforesaid facts, interim order dated 17.10.2019 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Both the parties i.e. accused and the complainant would be at liberty to seek their remedy in accordance with law at the time of filing cancellation report of version and cross-version before the Illaqa Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
