In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be disposed of by issuing a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of. The Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) is directed to ensure that remaining 08 PWs are examined within a period of two months from today. The trial Court is also directed to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of six months from today.
