The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.19, dated 23.06.2019, registered under Sections 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 379, 411, 473 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran.

2. Ld. Counsel for the State with reference to the citation, mentioned in the last order, submits in all fairness that he has been unable to locate any decision or citation to counter the reliance of the Petitioner.

3. The weight of the 10 loose Capsules out of the contraband allegedly seized from the Petitioner, in the given circumstances, would come to only 6.07 grams, which is marginally above the small quantity.

4. As such, considering the long detention of the Petitioner in this case since 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2019 and the fact that he is not required for the purpose of investigation, at this stage, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
