Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of FIR No. 0048 dated 23.03.2018 registered under Sections 279, 337, 427 IPC, registered at P.S. Phase I, SAS Nagar Mohali, and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 18.10.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before learned Chief Judicial Magistrate-cum- Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), SAS Nagar, Mohali, on 13.02.2020 to get their statements recorded. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate-cum-Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), SAS Nagar, Mohali, has submitted her report vide letter bearing No. 28 dated 18.02.2020, duly forwarded by learned

District and Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali, vide letter No. 1736 dated 19.02.2020.

According to the above report, compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR No. 0048 dated 23.03.2018 registered under Sections 279, 337, 427 IPC, registered at P.S. Phase I, SAS Nagar Mohali, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.
