On 18.10.2019, following order was passed:-

“It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted. The petitioner is not involved in the drug trafficking, as is alleged in the FIR. The only basis for involving the name of the petitioner; is alleged disclosure statement of the co-accused and the alleged secret information. However, to substantiate these allegations, there is no material with the Police; even prima facie to show that the petitioner is involved in such activities. It is further submitted that there is no other case of any kind against the petitioner.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

It has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation in pursuance of above said order dated 18.10.2019 and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh, has not disputed the above said fact.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 18.10.2019, is made absolute.
