For the reasons stated in the application, main appeal is restored to its original number.

Application is allowed.

For the reasons stated in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, delay of 2187 days in filing the application for leave to appeal is condoned.

Application is allowed.

Main case

With the consent of learned counsel for the appellant, main case is taken on board today itself for final disposal.

The appellant has filed the criminal complaint alleging harassment at work place. Since, the appellant did not appear before the Court, the Chief Judicial Magistrate after appreciating the facts available on the file, dismissed the complaint. The Court has noticed that the appellant has also filed civil litigation in this regard. The suit was also dismissed vide judgment and decree dated 16.05.2008, affirmed in appeal by the Appellate Authority.

The Court has also noticed that Superintending Engineer, BWS, Kaithal, has also conducted an enquiry and found that the appellant is in the habit of making false allegations.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant leave to appeal is made out.

Dismissed.
