This application is filed for preponing the date of hearing in the main appeal.

It is stated in the application that the settlement has been arrived at between the appellants/claimants and the Insurance Company.

Issue notice to respondent No.2- Insurance Company.

At this stage, Ms. Sheenu Sura, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2-Insurance Company. She states that she has no objection if the main appeal is preponed as indeed the settlement has been arrived at.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the main appeal is preponed from 16.04.2020 to today itself.

Main Case.

Learned counsel for the appellants states that he does not press this appeal as the settlement has been arrived between the appellants and respondent No.2-Insurance Company.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that the matter has indeed been compromised and she has handed over four cheques for total amount of ₹72,000/- i.e. Cheque No.189302 for ₹ 25,000/-, cheque No.189303 for ₹15,666/-, cheque No.189304 for ₹15,666/- and cheque No.189305 for ₹15,666/- to the counsel for the appellants. She further contends that this payment is over and above the payment which has already been disbursed to the claimants in terms of the award.

In view of the above, this appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement.
