Prayer in this application is for disposing of the main petition as the offence in question has been compounded by the lower appellate Court/Special Judge, Punjab, S.A.S. Nagar, vide order dated 01.02.2020.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that an application under Section 340 Cr.P.C. was filed before the lower appellate Court and since the Company Court has granted permission for compounding the offence, the lower appellate Court, on the basis of the same, has compounded the offence, however, since the lower appellate Court was restrained from passing the final order, vide order dated 03.02.2016 passed by this Court, therefore, this petition may be disposed of in order to enable the lower appellate Court to pass the final order in terms of order dated 01.02.2020.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 and 2 have no objection to the prayer of the applicant-petitioner.

Criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
