The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.96 dated 19.06.2019 registered under Sections 308, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, further added Section 307 in Challan vide order dated 20.08.2019 at Police Station Nhal Singh Wala, District Moga.

On 28.05.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Prayer in this application is for preponement of the date of hearing of the main case.

Power of Attorney filed on behalf of the complainant verified from the WhatsApp Message sent up in the Group.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the prayer for preponement is allowed and the main case is taken up on Board, for consideration, today itself.

CRM stands disposed off.

CRM-M No.44700 of 2019

As the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement, the applicant/petitioner, who is in detention for well over 10 months now, he is ordered to be released on an interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate, concerned, till the next date already fixed in the main petition, i.e., 08.07.2020.”

Learned counsels for the first informant as well as the State jointly submit that the parties have entered into a settlement.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the interim order dated 28.05.2020 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
